Our commitment to Safeguarding Children

In Aqua Paradise Resort, the owners and the senior management strongly believe that it is crucial to eliminate any possibility for a child or young person to experience any kind of physical, emotional or sexual abuse, neglect or exploitation. To be in compliance with the United Nations Convention on the Rights of the Child it is our commitment to respect and safeguard all children and young people under the age of 18 who stay in our property as well as those who work or live in our locality, ensuring that they are protected from all forms of abuse, exploitation or neglect.

The owners and the senior management of Aqua Paradise Resort consider the welfare of the child or young person to be paramount. We work actively in order to ensure that every child or young person under the age of 18 has the right to be equally protected from abuse, neglect or exploitation irrespective of age, disability, gender, race, religious believe, sexual orientation or sexuality.

To apply our Safeguarding Children Policy we will:

1. Respect, value and listen to the needs of children and young people.
2. Support the elimination of exploitative child labor.
3. Ensure that we comply with all applicable Children's Rights laws and regulations.
4. We raise awareness on the matter of child abuse or exploitation by training our staff in accordance with our Safeguarding Children Policy, with the reason of them being sensitive to the signs of abuse, neglect or exploitation. This will help them to know what actions should be taken in case of any concerns noticed.
5. By uploading our Safeguarding Children's Policy on our website, we intend to promote our policy to suppliers, sub-contractors, stakeholders and guests.
6. With regards to the protection of children's rights in cases of grossly obscene or inappropriate behavior towards children including sexual assault the staff and guests should alert the relevant authorities: Hotel Management, security, police to take appropriate measures.
We appeal for vigilant attitude towards every child outside and within the hotel.
7. At seeing or receiving information about a child who is visibly suffering from parental or any person aggression (with traces of injuries, beating, weeping, being left alone in the room without parents or being at the bar late at night) to report to immediately to reception or the hotel management so if necessary the appropriate authorities will be informed.
